As we continue to seek God during our reset, He has confirmed many times that He is calling us to minister to more than just the residents who will be living at the Dream House. Over the last couple months, we have reconnected with several of the youth we worked with at our previous ministry, Center for Champions. One of those being Anyea. When Anyea was 16, she was one of four teens selected to go on a trip with us to the Dream Center in LA. Now, almost 20, and a mother of an 18 month old, she reconnected with us and we instantly felt led to intervene in the negative situation. She

gave her daughter the middle name Dream (and refers to her as Dream). Why? "I call her Dream because that trip was so impactful and I never want to forget it. She is also my reminder to keep going after my dreams." And now, here she is living at the Dream House with her daughter Dream! Anyea is working hard at Commonwealth Senior Living Center. It is a lot to juggle being a young mom and working a full time job, but with some help she is doing it! We feel honored to be able to give her the tools she needs, while encouraging her that, with one step at a time, her dreams will come true!
